UPCOMING

Cognitive Abilities Test

Third grade students will be administered the CogAT test on October 11 - 13, 2016. This test measures general thinking and problem solving skills. The test will be taken over a three day time span with the allotted time of thirty minutes per test.

Weekly Reports

HOT TOPICS

MATH:

We have been learning to solve addition and subtraction word problems using the Thinking Blocks method.. Along with that students have been learning to add three digit numbers and subtract with regrouping.

READING:

Students have been learning about the importance of generating questions. We practiced together and independently, how to ask and answer questions. Some questioning thinking stems are "I wonder" and "How". Ask "When do we ask questions?" Also, ask them "What is real reading?"

WRITING:

We have reviewed capitalization and complete sentences. Ask your child about M.I.N.T.S. We also have been working on generating ideas and are beginning narratives.
